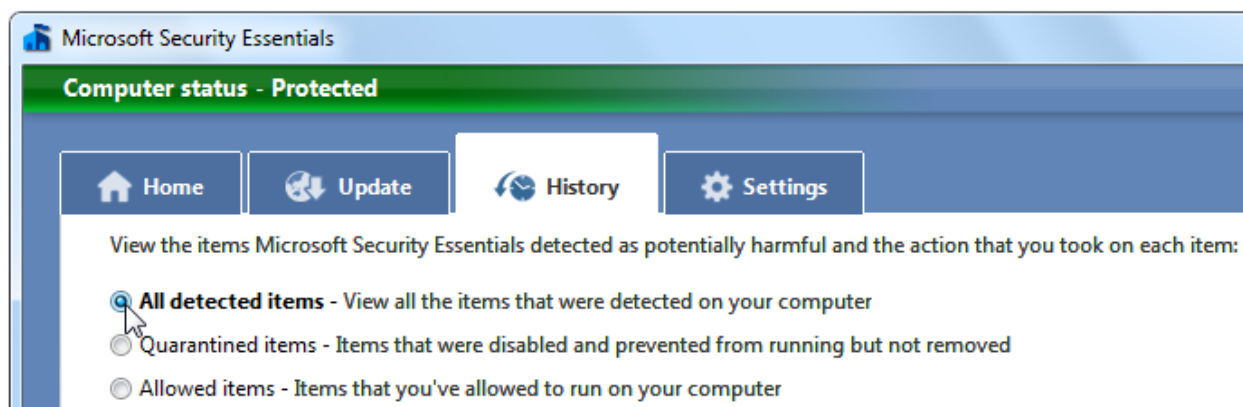
To view or delete history

1. To open Microsoft® Security Essentials you must double-click its  icon.
2. Click the **History** tab.

3. Select **All detected items**.

4. To delete all items in the list, click  **Delete history**.

 **Security note:** If UAC is enabled, then you'll get a UAC prompt on screen. Please specify credentials or permission to pass the UAC elevation.
